Central Theme

The best interest of children and adolescents: Well-being and development in the new world economic order.

Thematic Areas

The program will be structured around six general thematic areas: poverty, education, health, participation, identity and violence. These have been drawn from the considerations and conclusions of the *Barcelona Declaration* authored by the children and adolescents who participated in the III World Congress on Child and Adolescent Rights in 2007.

Each thematic area will be developed in a plenary address as well as in thematic sessions organized within a general context and two specific contexts: early childhood and adolescence.
